As at the end of 2001, 247 leasing companies and 23 factoring companies had registered with Bank Negara Malaysia (BNM). However, only 138 leasing companies and 19 factoring companies submitted statisticspertaining to their operations to BNM. Total assets of the 138 leasing companies and 19 factoring companies amounted to RM17.1 billion and RM4.7 billion respectively at the end of 2001. Nevertheless, of the 138 leasing companies, only 41 were pure leasing companies, while of the 19 factoring companies, only 12 were pure factoring companies. The remaining companies only undertook leasing and factoring business as part of their overall business activities.
